# NEW YORK STATE POLICE AGREEMENT FOR PROVIDING CARE OF ANIMALS SEIZED AS EVIDENCE IN AN ANIMAL CRUELTY INVESTIGATION

agrees to assist the New York State Police by taking custody of the animal(s) seized in connection with a criminal investigation of animal cruelty and accepts the following conditions of this agreement:

1. The animal(s) identified in paragraph 2 have been seized under exigent circumstances to rescue the animal from immediate danger of injury/death or pursuant to a lawfully issued search warrant to inspect animal(s) on the premises of:

3. The Assisting Organization shall ensure that the above, identified animals are housed in a manner that no breeding will take place and risk of injury to the animal(s) is minimized. Males and Females must be housed separately and any animal(s) that are incompatible with others must be housed separately.

4. The Assisting Organization shall assume all liability for personal injury or property damage caused by any animal(s) identified in this agreement. The Assisting Organization shall indemnify, defend and hold the New York State Police, its members and employees harmless from, and against any and all claims and liabilities arising out of any claims or suits, or threats of suits, which may be brought or made against the New York State Police arising from damage or injury caused by any animal identified in this agreement.

5. The Assisting Organization further agrees to abide by any court order providing for the ultimate disposition of the animal(s). The Assisting Organization acknowledges that such court order may require the following action or combination of actions:

- (a) Allow the Assisting Organization to adopt out the animal(s).
- (b) Order the euthanization of the animal(s) as appropriate.
- (c) Require the return of the animal(s) to the defendant.

6. In the event that the Assisting Organization requires financial reimbursement for expenses incurred as a result of boarding and housing the animal(s) identified in this agreement, the Assisting Organization shall be responsible for making a petition to the criminal court adjudicating the case and request that as part of the final disposition of the case, the defendant be ordered to pay necessary expenses for the care of the animal(s) in accordance with Article 26 of the New York State Agriculture and Markets Law.
