A motion was made by Biondolillo and seconded by Gracey that the board accept Dog Pound/Shelter contract as amended and to authorize the Supervisor to sign agreement. Carried Ayes 5 Nay 0.

A motion was made by Biondolillo and seconded by Carpenter that the board approve the union contract. Carried Ayes 5 Nay 0.

A motion was made by Eisenhauer and seconded by Carpenter that the board set a public hearing for Local Law #5-2021 on November 4, 2021, immediately following the scheduled public hearing at 4:10 p.m. to amend Local Law #3-2021 to correct a clerical error on rate of .01075 for Water District #3.
