The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Taylor at 4:00 p.m. with the following present:

A motion was made by Eisenhauer and seconded by Biondolillo to adopt the minutes of the regular meeting held on January 14, 2021. Carried Ayes 5 Nay 0.

Simon Glick was questioning the setback for the fire hydrant requirement that the zoning officer stated that he needed to be at for his driveway. They are asking the Town Board to wave that requirement. Town Attorney stated that the Town Board does not have the authority to do that. That it would need to go the Zoning Board of Appeals

Mark Rusch, resident from Riverbend Estates put a purchase offer on the Town property that we have for sale on Riverbend which is next to the Rusch property. The Board told him that we would have to discuss his offer in executive session.

Walt Hammond towns insurance agent from Haylor Freyor and Coon reported that the insurance rates were going up about 2% this year.

Steve Marshall, DANC gave his monthly report.

A motion was made by Biondolillo and seconded by Gracey that the combined computergenerated report and detailed statement of Justices Clark and Covell for the year <u>2020</u> were presented and examined, the fines and fees collected had been turned over to the proper officials. A motion was made by Carpenter and seconded by Biondolillo that the board approve the NYSDOT Emergency Shared Service Agreement effective 2/11/2021 to 2/11/2025. Carried Ayes 5 Nay 0.
